

ITCS update

- In late August, NERC released the first of three documents that will constitute the Interregional Transfer Capability Study (ITCS)
- The Transfer Capability Analysis (Part 1) examines the current total transfer capabilities between neighboring transmission regions
- Prudent Additions (Part 2) and Recommendations (Part 3) are scheduled to be published in November
- The <u>Overview of Study Need and Approach</u> was released in late June
 - Provides context for the study details and explains the need for the study

- Starting point: Year 20 Foundational Case
 - Year 20 Cold Weather Event Study
 - Year 20 Extreme Heat Event Study
 - Year 20 Compound Load Impacts Study
 - Year 20 Transmission Trends Assessment
- Overview and results: Year 20 Load, Resource, and Transmission trends



Background

- Balancing Authorities (BA) submit their 10-year plans annually
 - Loads
 - Resources
 - Transmission topology
 - May not completely match their IRP
- Anchor Data Set (ADS) every two years
 - One year, 10 years out
 - Puts all the pieces together for the WI






Y20 Approach

Year 20

Foundational Case


- 2032 ADS -> 2042 Foundational Case
- Focused on major drivers: Load and Resources
 - Benchmarked against EIA AEO, NREL EFS
 - Resource additions limited to wind, solar, energy storage
- No change to transmission topology
 - Only included what was provided for the 2032 ADS
- No change to prices
 - Didn't look at cost
 - Resource Adequacy perspective
 - Assumed same dispatch order
- Technical stakeholder advisory groups of industry volunteers
- Consulting firm—E3





Lessons Learned

- Modeling shortcoming of energy storage
- Historical data/curves/profiles may not reflect future
- Transmission plan timing
- Resource plans beyond five years tend to be generic
- Pipe and bubble may be better approach
 - Increased Precision ≠ Increased Accuracy





Future

- Data improvements
 - Requesting BA/utility long-term resource plans
 - FERC 1920: 20-year transmission planning
- Model improvements
 - Energy storage modeling
 - Detailed -> Pipe and bubble
- Approach or Method
 - Collaborating with others for their ideas and lessons
 - Consider other drivers such as technology, policies
