## WRAP Membership

- Xcel (PSCo) signed WRAPA; WRAP effective September 15, 2026 (onboarding underway)
- Constellation submitted expedited withdrawal, exiting WRAP effective May 31, 2026

## Markets+ Integration Timeline

# General WRAP Updates

---

## **Advanced Assessment Study Scope (Summer 2028 & Winter 2028-29)**

- Adding new Rockies subregion (associated load / resource zones) with addition of Xcel/PSCO
- Updated seasonal durations and peaks months and use of rolling 40 years of weather data

## **Contingency Reserve Update**

- WPP reviewing impacts of BAL-002-WECC-3 retirement
- New contingency reserve methodology expected to reduce capacity requirements
- NTFP with potential tariff/BPM updates targeting WRAP Board-approval in December 2026
- Impacts to be reflected ahead of the Winter 2027-28 binding season

# WRAP Task Force Updates

---

## Review DR QCC TF Proposal – Michael O’Brien, WPP

Proposal includes the following changes to the WRAP:

- A new QCC methodology for DR Capacity Resources based on the monthly average availability of such a resource during the appropriate ten-Year set of Capacity Critical Hours (CCH) subject to the constraints of the DR program; and
- An updated Capability Testing requirement for DR Capacity Resources that is a demonstration of the maximum load reduction at either: the daily hourly limit (maximum number of hours per day claimed); or, for resources with weekly or monthly hourly limits, for one hour.
- Operational Testing requirements will remain the same.

Public comment period closed May 15; input received from:

- BPA: Proposed modeling QCC of both hourly and daily fatigue for DR programs in the future
- APS: Suggested exploring DR and behind-the meter generation tied to load (e.g., data centers) that may increase with load; also suggested more discussion of scenarios with data centers that may have load shared by two participants
